ADDITIONAL WORKPLACE POSTERS

- ❑ AZ Municipal Posters – Employers with employees who perform work in TUCSON must post the Anti-Discrimination Poster (#03708 / #03709) and the Minimum Wage Poster (#03712 Bilingual). Employers with employees who perform work in FLAGSTAFF must post the Minimum Wage Poster. (#03710)
- ❑ AZ NO SMOKING POSTERS – Must be posted in all enclosed areas of public places and places of employment. (#03700 / #03701)
- ❑ AZ ALCOHOL PREGNANCY WARNING POSTER – Must be posted in restaurants, hotels, motels and retailers. (#03707)
- ❑ AZ WORKERS' COMPENSATION FRAUD POSTER – Optional poster that provides examples of common forms of workers' compensation fraud and describes the penalties for violating the law. (#03300 EN, #03301 SP)
